





Throughout our operations, we remain mindful of our environmental impact and continuously optimize our routes and fleet efficiency.

Sustainability – living responsibility

As a globally active family company, we are committed to implementing environmentally friendly and resource-efficient practices across all business areas. Our sustainability concept is realised on multiple levels:

- We source our wood exclusively from **certified, sustainably managed forests**.
- New company buildings are **constructed using timber**, while expansions of existing sites include sustainable upgrades such as electric-vehicle charging stations, energy-efficient LED lighting, and solar panels.
- We actively minimise our environmental footprint by keeping **transport routes** short and continuously investing in our vehicle fleet to meet the latest environmental standards.
- **We reuse production waste to heat our facilities.**
- Through our “**My Tree**” planting campaign, we contribute to the long-term reforestation of Swiss forests.
- These measures reflect our conviction that sustainability begins with action – today and for the generations to come.

Sustainability in numbers & facts

Through the **new and converted buildings** on our company premises, 9853 tons of CO₂ are bound for many years and withdrawn from the atmosphere through the use of wood and wood-based materials. To compare:
A 40-ton truck can travel over 8 million km.



Our photovoltaic systems produce annually 3.1 GWh of electricity. We use approx. 66 % for our own use.

As a globally active family enterprise, we are dedicated to implementing environmentally friendly and resource-efficient measures in everything we do. Our certified quality management system (ISO 9001) and our internal control processes ensure transparent material sourcing, legal compliance, and the achievement of long-term goals. Most importantly, they enable us to offer products that are manufactured sustainably.

We take our responsibility seriously when it comes to the use of wood – a natural and renewable raw material. Wherever possible, we source from producers who work with certified forests, verified by FSC®, PEFC, and Swiss Wood certifications. These seals confirm that our products come from responsibly managed forests and meet the requirements for traceability and environmental compliance.



The Butterfly Seal of Quality

Products that carry the Butterfly label for low-emission wood-based materials are tested by independent construction and environmental chemistry institutes. They meet strict standards for reducing volatile organic compounds (VOC) and help ensure healthier indoor environments.



Produced with Swiss wood

We act locally to protect nature and conserve resources. The Produced with Swiss Wood product line uses timber sourced 66 % – 100 % from Swiss forests. This supports the domestic forestry sector and strengthens the market for high-quality, locally produced wood-based materials.

We also view training as an opportunity to attract and nurture highly qualified young talent – an integral part of our corporate culture. At present, we provide vocational training in the following professions:



From tradition to innovation

When Alfred Kuratle founded the sole proprietorship Kuratle AG in Laufenburg, Aargau, in 1955, he could hardly have foreseen that he was laying the foundation for today's Kuratle Group. In 1974, his son George Kuratle joined the family business and, after taking over management in the early 1990s, set a decisive course for the company's future.

Recognising early on that the market demanded a broader range of products and services than a single trading company could provide, he initiated a series of strategic mergers and integrations that fueled sustained growth. These milestones established the foundation for meeting the evolving needs of the timber industry.

Guided by the company's vision of offering customers comprehensive timber solutions in trade, production, and logistics, the Kuratle Group ultimately expanded beyond Switzerland's borders – combining family tradition with international reach.
